US 69 Corridor: Gateway to the Big Thicket Segment

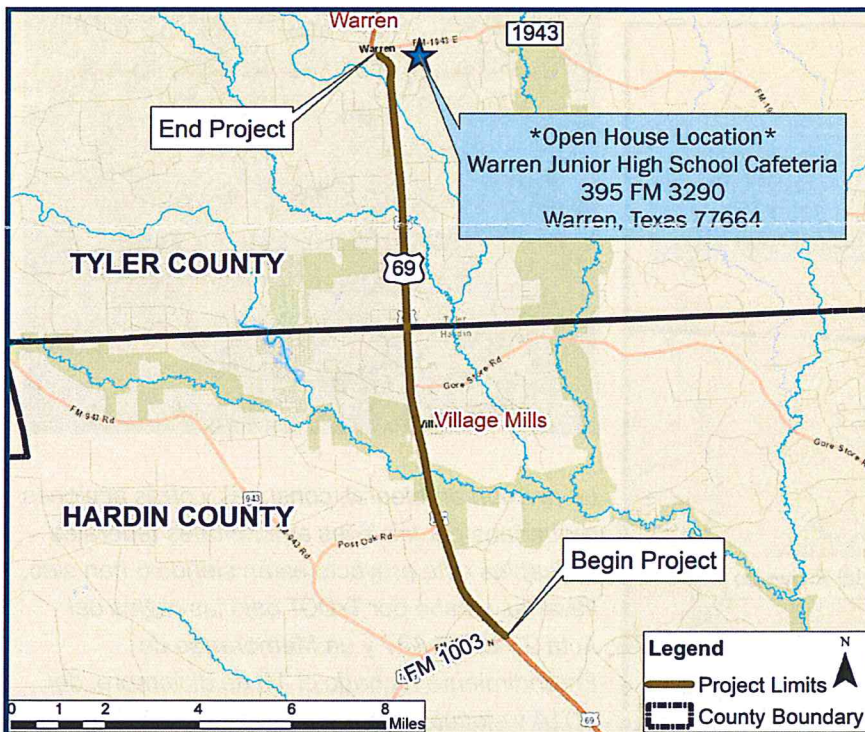
The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Beaumont District will host an Open House to gather input on the proposed widening and design improvements to an approximately 13-mile stretch of US 69, from FM 1003 (north of Kountze in Hardin County) to FM 1943 (near Warren in Tyler County).

The Open House will have no formal presentation; attendees can come-and-go at their convenience. Staff will be on hand to discuss the proposed improvements, answer questions and show maps of the study area and proposed alternatives.

All interested community members are invited to attend this Open House. The Open House will be conducted in English.
